Background:

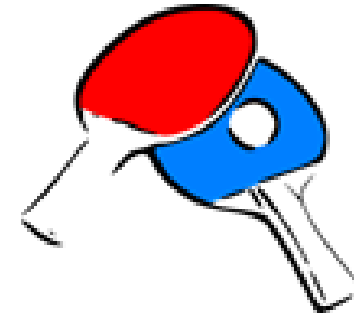
